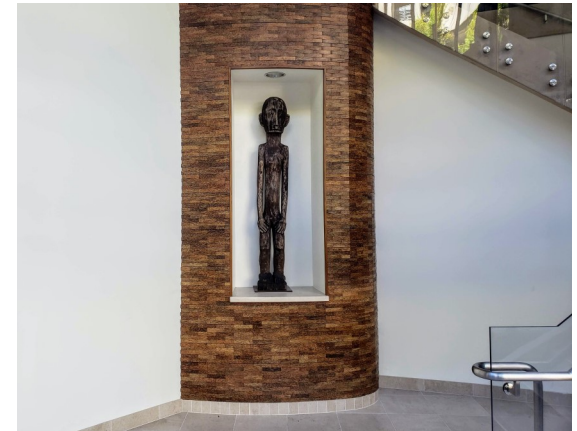
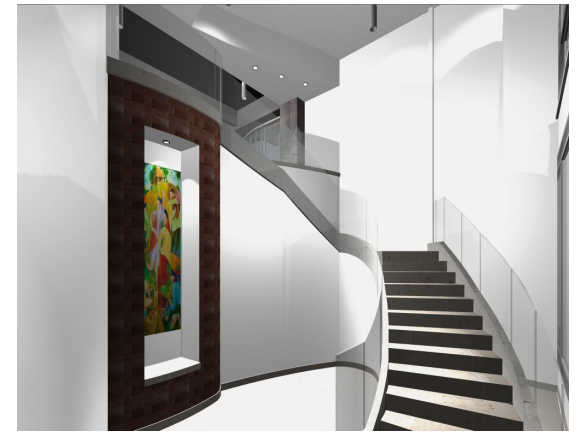

Who We Are

In 1999, a group of Filipino community leaders, advocates, and supporters envisioned the San Francisco Filipino Cultural Center to become a preferred destination to visit, "a magnet" for the City's residents, visiting Filipinos, and tourists.

Foremost, the cultural center would house artifacts, books, paintings, and sculptures, serving as a showcase and depository of the best in Philippine artistry through visual and performing arts, including technology-based mixed media.

SFFCC would also be a place to educate the Filipino community about their rich, diverse history. The planners, in their wisdom, saw the need of a research institution that would identify and curate the finest artworks --- and highlight the art forms, culture, and history that is uniquely Filipino.

These advocates started negotiations to build a world class, community-friendly, and accessible cultural center. It took almost 18 years to make it happen. They patiently weathered several moves of their dream cultural center from Westfield Mall to Metreon San Francisco, a restaurant-centric shopping mall, to its current location, a 9,000 square foot space at the mezzanine level of The Bulletin Building.

Today, the board of directors is ramping up the center's activities and operations so that SFFCC truly becomes the heart and hub of the communities they serve.
